Training is required to attend the meetings and be part of the program. The GSEM offer all trainings. Our troops are huge and fun! New events and lots of activities for the girls are planned! |
| How:                          | The annual Girl Scout Registration fee is \$12.00. The troop's monthly dues are \$5.00 per month for 10 months. They are due at the first meeting of each month (pre-pay in full at registration and you will receive a \$5.00 discount). Troop dues pay for the girls badges, patches and pins. As well the girls learn to manage their money to pay for supplies and activities.  |
| Uniforms:                     | Girl Scouting offers a wide range of uniform options at various cost. Our uniform that is required for school wear on meeting days and or "official GS activities" are a khaki bottom and white top. They should be "school uniform in style" no cargos, short shorts, tank tops Girls are always in uniform when they wear their Girl Scout pin! Flyers and information for girl's sashes, tunics vests, patches and books will be available to order on registration night.   |
