We are sending this note to keep you apprised of our progress in the pre-k. Our library and the Extended Day Room have become the temporary classrooms for the pre-k classes. The teachers have done a wonderful job transitioning and carrying on with the children in their temporary rooms. The restoration company has finished its work and has assured us there is no mold or mildew in the pre-k. The damaged floors, windows, equipment, and supplies have been removed. The insurance company representative has been here a number of times to help assess the situation.

The contractors have been in and work should begin late this week. Four floors will be replaced as well as two windows. The walls in the hallway will be repainted and new carpets will be put down. The classrooms will then have to be put back in order and supplies that were damaged will begin to be replaced.

Parents, teachers and members of our community have expressed an interest in helping with the final steps of organizing and setting up the classrooms.
